



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



- 1. The MAH-LLB-3Years CET 2021 Examination will be conducted online. You will be required to enter Login ID and Password to start the examination. Login ID and Password will be provided on the Hall Ticket. Please ensure that your name and other details which will subsequently appear on the Screen are CORRECT. You must maintain the secrecy of your Login ID and Password. It is your responsibility.
- 2. You are required to bring this Hall Ticket along with your own recent photo affixed thereon and currently valid photo Identity proof in original such as i) PAN card/ii) Indian Passport/iii) Driving License/ iv) Voter's Card/ v) Bank Passbook with photograph/vi) Photo identity proof issued by a Gazetted officer on official letterhead along with Photograph/vii) Photo identity proof issued by a people's representative on official letterhead along with photograph/viii) Recent identity card issued by a recognized School/College/Aadhaar Card/E-Aadhaar card with a photograph. ix) ix)Employee ID, x) Bar Council Identity Card with Photograph.Soft copy/colour copy of the photo ID card will not be accepted. Please note that your name as appearing on the Hall Ticket (provided by you during the process of registration) should reasonably match with the name as appearing on the photo identity proof. Female candidates who have changed first/last/middle name post marriage must take special note of this. - 4. You must bring a Ballpoint Pen with you.
- 5. The mere fact that the Hall Ticket has been issued to you does not imply that your Candidature has been finally cleared by State CET Cell or that the entries made by you in your application for the examination have been accepted by State CET Cell as true and correct. It may be noted that State CET Cell will take up verification of eligible candidates, i.e., educational qualifications and category with reference to original documents, only at the time of Admission of candidates who qualify on the basis of the result of the online CET Examination. You may therefore please note that if at any stage you do not satisfy the eligibility criteria as given in the notification or the information furnished by you in the application is incorrect, your candidature is liable to be cancelled forth-with with such further actions as State CET Cell may like to take.
- 6. Your responses (answers) will be analyzed with other candidates to detect patterns of similarity of right and wrong answers. If in the analytical procedure adopted in this regard, it is inferred/concluded that the responses have been shared and scores obtained are not genuine/valid, your candidature may be cancelled and/or the result withheld.
- 7. You must report at the Examination Venue a Minimum of 1 hour before the time as printed on this Hall Ticket. Candidates arriving late will not be permitted to appear for the on-line examination at any cost and the candidate himself/herself will be responsible for that. Outstation candidates should visit the center a day before for calculating the time required in commute/travel.
- 8. Use of Books, Notebooks, Calculators, Watch Calculators, Pagers, Mobile Phone etc. is not permitted in this Examination. Candidates are advised not to bring any of the banned items including mobile phones/pagers to the venue of examination as safety arrangements cannot be assured. The candidate himself will be responsible for the safe custody of the mobile phone and electronic gadgets. - 1. As a precaution for COVID-19, the candidate must reach Centre as indicated against Reporting/Entry time at Centre, in the Admit Card.
- 2. No candidate shall be permitted to enter after the Gate Closing Time.
- 3. No candidate shall be permitted to leave the Examination Room/ Hall before the end of the examination.
- 4. On completion of the examination, please wait for instructions from Invigilator and do not get up from your seat until advised. The candidates will be permitted to move out, one at a time only
- 5. All candidates are required to download and read carefully, the Instructions and Advisory for COVID-19 given with the Admit Card and strictly adhere to them.
- 6. This Admit Card consists of three pages- Page 1 contains the **Centre details and Self Declaration (Undertaking) form regarding COVID-19**, Page 2 has **"Important instruction for candidates"** and Page 3 has **"Advisory for candidates regarding COVID-19"**. The candidate has to download all three pages.

- 10. No Candidate would be allowed to enter the Examination Centre, without Admit Card and undertaking, Valid ID Proof and proper frisking. Frisking through Handheld Metal Detector (HHMD), will be carried out without touching the body.
- 11. Candidates will be permitted to carry only the following items with them into the examination venue :

- 14. The candidate must bring PwD certificate issued by the Competent Authority if claiming relaxation under PwD category. The scribe must also carry his/ her own Self Declaration(Undertaking) regarding educational qualification, etc., passport size photograph, valid government identity and self-declaration (Undertaking) regarding COVID-19 (as per above format).
- 15. Examination Officials will not be responsible for safe keeping of personal belongings and there will be no facility.
