

Agreement:

This memorandum was drawn on between Carmel Vidya Bhavan Trust's Christ College Pune, 26/4 A, Off Pune Nagar Road, Opposite Weikfield IT Citi Info Park, 26/4A, Nagar Rd, Ramwadi, Wadgaonsheri, Pune, Maharashtra 411014, which is affiliated to Savitribai Phule Pune University, represented by Dr (Fr) Arun Antony Chully CMI, Director hereafter referred as First Party and Shri Swami Samarth Enterprises, 507, Shukrawar Peth, Near Vanraj Mandal, Shivaji Road,



Pune - 411002, represented by Mr. Sanjay Lagas, Waste paper & Scrap Merchant hereafter referred as Second Party.

The duration of the agreement shall be for a period of five (5) years.

Purpose/ Scope:

Carmel Vidya Bhavan Trust's Christ College Pune and Shri Swami Samarth Enterprises has developed the memorandum of Understanding (MOU) to achieve the following goals: 1. Encourage the adoption of sustainable waste management practices that minimize

environmental impact and resource consumption.

2. Maintain a healthy and positive environment for the students and staff in the campus.

3. Promote the concept of recycling the paper waste and other solid wastes including plastic waste, glass and metal waste among the students.

 Implement waste management practices that protect and enhance biodiversity on campus, including preserving natural habitats.

5. To support implementing Green Initiatives, especially the waste management activities within the campus.

Responsibilities:

- First party will collect and do the preliminary sorting process of the solid waste/scrap. It will
 be stored in the campus storage systems convenient for the second party to transport to their
 processing centers.
- Second party shall collect waste papers and other scraps including plastic waste by its representatives in every 2 months or at a lesser time period after informing first party at least 24 hours prior.
- The second party will be responsible fully for the processing of it as per the norms of the government/ authorities.
- 4. The authorized persons/ employee of the second party will be permitted to enter in campus for sorting the scrap under the supervision of the staff of the first party on request. Electricity and basic facilities for the scrap management will be provided in a regulated manner by the



first party against request. The way bill and other requirements as per norms will be provided for the smooth transportation of the items.

Statement of Mutual benefit and interest:

No Confidentiality: No information pertaining to this MoU and implementation thereof shall be treated as confidential by either party, The information sought by any staff or any RTI applicant shall be provided as per records promptly.

Second Party shall give an amount equal to the average of amount quoted by 3 bidders to the first party in lieu of recyclable waste material provided that the cost of scrap collected exceeds Rs. 1000/- Circumstances may arise which may call for alterations or modifications or amendments to this agreement. These alterations or modifications or amendments will be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing. No amendment or change shall be made without the notice of both parties.

Any disagreement or dispute between the two parties shall be discussed and solved mutually holding a meeting consisting of the representatives from both the parties. Any party can withdraw from this MOU after informing the other party at least 3 months prior. The liabilities and dues shall be met before the period of agreement ends.

The Memorandum of Understanding is signed between Carmel Vidya Bhavan Trust's Christ College Pune (Affiliated to Savitribai Phule Pune University) and Shri Swami Samarth Enterprises. The above-mentioned terms and conditions are fully read and understood by both parties. The parties hereto have executed this Agreement as of the Effective Date 19.09.2022.



WASTE MANAGEMENT AGREEMENT

This Agreement, entered into on 8th December, 2021 as the "Effective Date" by and between Christ College ,Pune having office at 26/4 A, Vadgaon Sheri, Off Pune Nagar Road Pune Maharashtra 411014, here in after called "Christ College - Pune" and Threco Recycling LLP, having its office at D-402 Remi Bizcourt, Shah Industrial Estate, Off Veera Desai Road, Andheri West, Mumbai 400053, here in after called "Threco".

Whereas Christ College, Pune has information technology peripheral including printers and material (the "Material" and as hereinafter defined) that it may from time to time wish to recycle, and Threco desires to execute a complete waste management program on behalf of Christ College, Pune to process the Material.

THEREFORE, Christ College, Pune shall provide, and Threco shall recycle the Material in accordance with the following terms of this Agreement:

1. Material:

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Material is hereinafter defined as all hazardous scrap. Material specifically excludes equipment containing radioactive materials, free flowing liquids, chlorofluorocarbons, polychlorinated biphenyls, or other "Hazardous Wastes".

2. Services:

a. Threco will ensure the E-waste generated and provided by Christ College, Pune is disposed of in a compliant manner.

c. Disposal Certificate, for the applicable material, will be provided to Christ College, Pune within 3 weeks from the date of receipt of material at the facility.

d. Cost of transportation will be borne by Threco.

3. Payment/Charges

One-time payment for the bin installation would be Rs.5000+ GST. Kindly consider the E-waste bin proposal. Threco will dispose and pick up the E-waste free of charge.

4. Threco Representation and Warranties:

4.1 In the performance of all Services to be provided hereunder, Threco agrees to comply with all applicable permits, all central, state, and local laws, regulations and ordinances and all duly constituted authorities. Upon request of Christ College, Pune, Threco shall furnish copies thereof to Christ College.

4.2 Threco will be responsible for the statutory compliances including environmental compliances pertaining to the scrap disposal activities and Christ College, Pune will not in any way be responsible for the same once the scrap material is handed over by Christ College, Pune to Threco.

4.3 Threco agrees and undertakes to indemnify Christ College, Pune for any liability, claims including third party claims, legal actions against Christ College,Pune arising out of any negligent action or wilful misconduct by Threco.

5 Representations and Warranties:

5.1 Christ College, Pune has free and unencumbered title to all Material delivered to Threeo pursuant of this Agreement.

5.2 Christ College, Pune shall issue all proper despatch documents, where applicable.

6 Terms:

This agreement shall have a term of Five (5) years from the Effective Date. Threco will be the official E-waste collector and recycler for the institution.

7. Independent Contractor:

In furnishing Services pursuant to this Agreement, either Party will at all times be acting as an independent contractor and this Agreement will not be construed to create any association, partnership, joint venture, relation of principal and agent or employer and employee between one Party and the other Party or its agents.

8. Miscellaneous:

8.1 All services performed by Threco for Christ College, Pune while this Agreement is in effect shall be subject to its provisions unless otherwise agreed in writing before the performance of such services is started.

8.2 This Agreement may be terminated at any time by Christ College, Pune or Threco, upon material breach by either party or upon 30 days written notice to the other party without any reason.

8.3 If any provision of this Agreement is held invalid or unenforceable, then it shall be considered severable (only to the extent necessary) and the remaining provisions will not be impaired and this Agreement will be interpreted as far as possible to give effect to its stated purpose.

8.4 This Agreement will benefit and bind Christ College, Pune Threco and their respective representatives, successors in interest, and mutually permitted assigns, as appropriate.

8.5 This Agreement constitutes and fully expresses the entire and only agreement between the parties with the respect to the subject matter thereof; all prior and collateral understandings, agreements and promises with respect thereto are considered merged herein. This Agreement may not be modified, waived, or extended unless mutually agreed to in writing, and it may not be terminated except as provided above. A waiver by either party of any terms and conditions of this Agreement in one or more instances will not constitute a permanent waiver of such terms and conditions unless so stated in writing.
