
DATE : 3rd March 2022 DURATION: 1 hour Volunteers' Participation: 50




CHRIST COLLEGE - PUNE NSS PLANTATION AT BAKORI VILLAGE








SWACHH BHARAT ABHIYAN AWARENESS THROUGH STREETPLAYS
