

VISIT TO AGA KHAN PALACE ON GANDHI JAYANTI

Date: 3rd October 2022 Beneficiaries: 50 students

On the occasion of Gandhi Jayanti, the students went for a trip to Aga Khan Palace. Historically, the palace holds great significance. Mahatma Gandhi, his wife Kasturba Gandhi and his secretary Mahadev Desai were interned in the palace from 9 August 1942 to 6 May 1944, following the launch of Quit India Movement. Kasturba Gandhi and Mahadev Desai died during their captivity period in the palace and have their Samadhis located over there. Mahatma Gandhi and Kasturba Gandhi have their memorials located in the same place. The students could have a glimpse of the life of Gandhiji through the museum and learnt about the values that are to be inculcated in one's life. Students and teachers also paid homage to the samadhi of Kasturba Gandhi at Aga Khan palace.

- Students shared their experience with other students of college and motivated them about the importance of values in one's life.






CONSTITUTION DAY

Felicitating Soldiers of Indian Army


