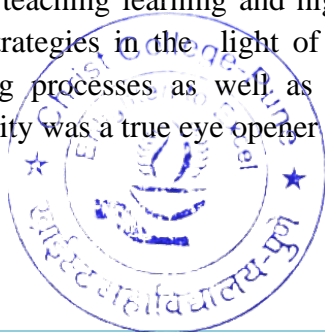
FACULTY ORIENTATION PROGRAMME

OPENING DAY CEREMONY – ODYSSEY'19



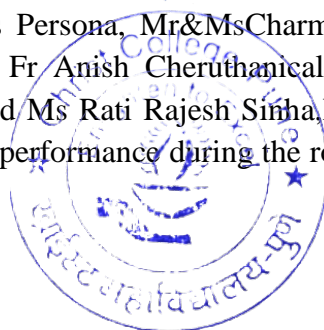

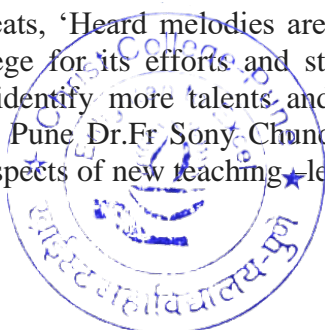
INTERCOLLEGE FEST – IMPULSE'19

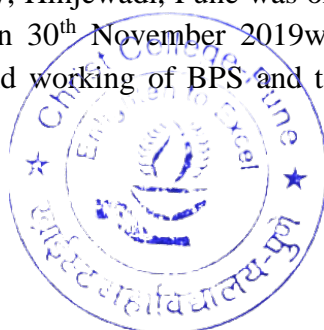

CAREER GUIDENCE PROGRAMMES

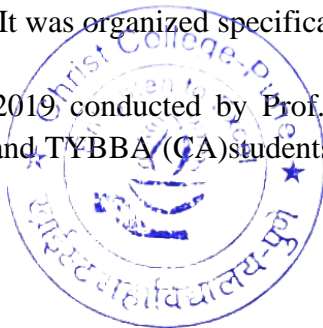

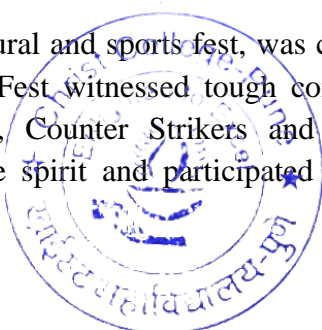
CHRISTMAS PROGRAMME

FACULTY EXCHANGE PROGRAMME

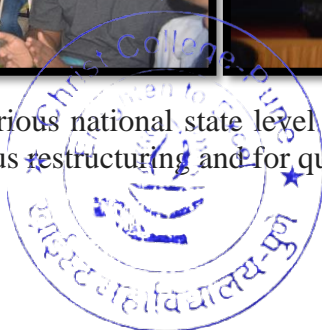
