Unity in Frame was held on 4th August 2023, a class wise photo contest exemplified the NSS's commitment to promoting values of unity, friendship, and collaboration among students.

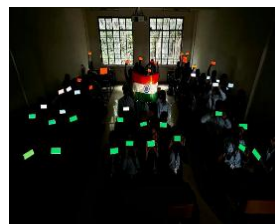

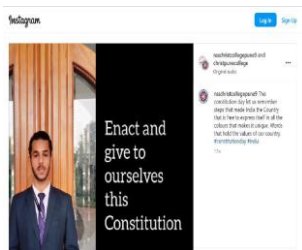
