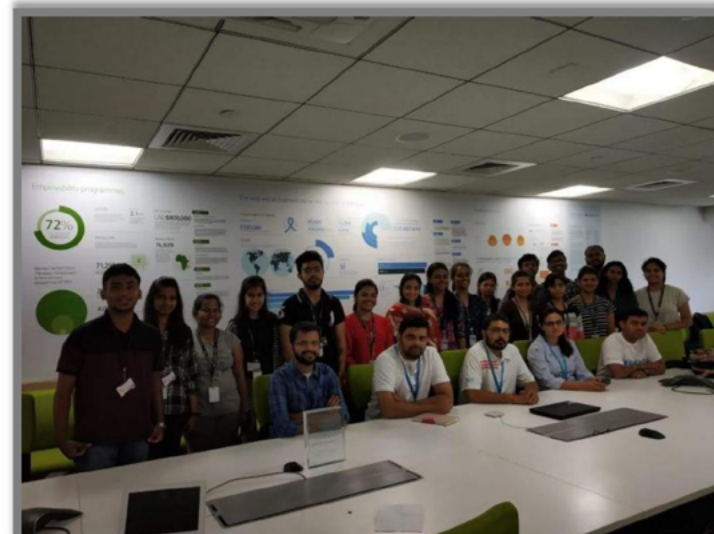

Christ College, Pune, had organized a visit to the well-known company Barclays for the Commerce students

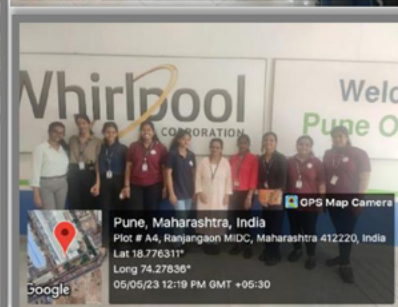

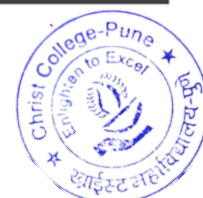

(Life Skill Connect with work)

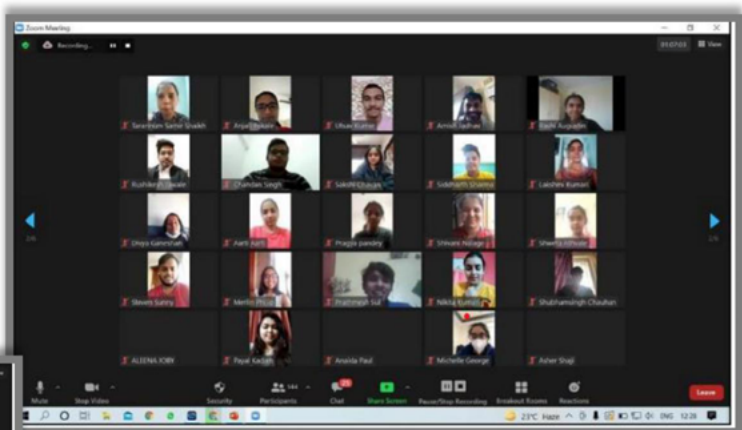
